2012, 2015 Western Michigan University sponsored College Day Trips required coordination with CPS staff and WMU.

Our nonprofit hosted and paid for transportation to/from, lunches for 7th & 8th and snacks and water for 7th, 8th, and 9th grade students.

- 7th Grade – 5/26/2012; 67 students, with 4 adult chaperones/CPS teachers
- 8th Grade – 5/24/2012, 80 students, with adult chaperones/CPS teachers
- 9th Grade – 5/25/2012, 61 students, with 4 chaperones/CPS teachers

- 7th Grade – 5/26/2015; 68 students, with 5 adult chaperones//CPS teachers
- 8th Grade – 5/28/2015, 77 students, with 5 adult chaperones/CPS teachers
- 9th Grade – 06/01/2015, 72 students – cancelled by chaperones/CPS teachers.

- 51 youth attended at least one day.
- 16 days total youth attendance = 490 students
- 19 High School students, community adults, teachers, Cass District Library & Junior Achievement, and Cass County 4-H volunteer involvement coordinated.

College Preview Day, Central State University, Wilberforce, Ohio

Nov. 9, 2012, Friday – Nov. 10, 2012, Saturday

Coordinated, financed, transported, and chaperoned 11-12 youth in grades 10th to 2012 high school graduate. Youth were from this local area and Kalamazoo Michigan. Youth traveled and stayed overnight.

Oct 2013 CPS Board Meeting Award presentation

- Acknowledged 7 community men coordinated by OFFKM, with the approval of CPS and teacher Ms. Kristine Wilderquist-Bosler, who allowed mentoring time for an academically and emotionally troubled male student from a single-family home.
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2013-2014 Coordinated, Hosted and Financially Sponsored a Bridges Out Of Poverty Club.

- Classes took place for fifteen weeks, beginning Sept. 18, 2013.
 - Generally, each evening class lasts for 2.5 hours.
 - Transportation to/from the evening class, a 30-minute meal and childcare were provided. The classes consist of co-investigators (those from the community wishing to understand their situations), co-facilitators (previous Getting Ahead graduates) and facilitators (volunteers from the community willing to help guide the class through the various topics).
 - Our 2014 graduation included 7 individuals who successfully completed the 15-week course.

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2015 Summer Program – Coordinated and Financially Sponsored

- Recruited, scheduled, provided in-house payroll for 9 certified teachers, 14 Youth Development Workers, 1 Custodian, 2 Educational Specialist
 - Monday – Friday, 7:30 a.m. – 4 p.m., 33 Weeks
 - Curriculum prepared with input from CPS teachers by hired professional educator.
 - Utilized hired professional educational evaluator and consultant with 40 years education experience.
 - 2,433 youth attendance counting each day attended, average 74 per day, K – 10th.
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
